Greenbrier Reservoir Rules and Regulations

Greenbrier Reservoir is our community's secondary source of drinking water, therefore we ask that you make every effort to keep the lake and surrounding area clean and free of debris and waste.

The following rules and regulations apply:

- No Littering.
- No Swimming.
- No Hunting, including Waterfowl
- No Drugs and/or Alcohol are permitted on the lake or grounds.
- Given this is a family oriented environment we ask that visitors refrain from any profanity and/or inappropriate acts or behavior.
- No gasoline motors are permitted to be operated on the lake, **ONLY ELECTRIC.**
- All persons under the age of 16 years old must be accompanied by an adult at least 21 years of age.
- All state and local game laws apply. **Fishing Licenses are Required.**
- No fishing will be allowed using trotlines, nets, jugs, or traps.
- No overnight camping. No camp fires or cooking fires are permitted.
- Any individual that fails to follow the posted rules will have access and usage privileges revoked, in addition to possible legal consequences.

Annual Usage Permits - \$50.00 per Household
